ELIGIBILITY

Open to all Blue Ridge Arts Council members (BRAC). Each entrant may submit one or two original works created within the last two years and not previously exhibited in our

MEDIA

Two-dimensional works of any medium: Watercolor, oil, pastel, gouache, collage, photography, acrylics, and mixed media. Framed pieces may be no more than 44" in width and 48" in height. Three-dimensional works may not exceed 50 pounds and may include clay, wood, metal, glass and fiber. Artwork must require no assembly and sit solidly on a flat surface or be mounted for hanging.

Work must be framed and wired for hanging. No clip mounts or saw tooth hangers will be accepted.

ENTRY FEE

A non-refundable fee of \$35 per artist for one or two entries is to be submitted upon delivery of work to the Blue Ridge Arts Center.

100% of net proceeds will go towards BRAC operating funds.

PROMOTIONAL RELEASE

Exhibitor grants BRAC and its respective successors the irrevocable right to take photographs of the Exhibitor's art work to be used strictly for advertising exhibits and BRAC. Photos of work will not be sold. Exhibitor can note their agreement to this on the Entry Form below.

LIABILITY

BRAC will handle work with utmost care but will not be responsible for loss or damage to the work. The Blue Ridge Art Center reserves the right to refuse any entry at its discretion.

A 35% sales commission is charged by BRAC. Work must remain for the duration of the exhibit.
