

Bluffton Arts & Seafood Festival Takes Place in Bluffton, SC - Oct. 13 - 21, 2018

The Bluffton Arts & Seafood Festival is back for the fourteenth year – and still growing. What started as a one-day event in 2005, has quickly become a week of festivities in historic Bluffton, SC, showcasing the arts and locally harvested seafood. Festival events are scheduled Saturday, Oct. 13 through Sunday, Oct. 21, 2018.

Along with the traditional Blessing of the Fleet and Boat Parade on the May River on Sunday, Oct. 14, the local art scene will again be highlighted as we kick off this week of festivities. Our Sunday activities include a Showcase of Local Art, at the galleries and an outdoor art exhibit from 11am - 4pm in the heart of Old Town Bluffton, as well as the first Oyster Roast of the season at Bluffton Oyster Park at 5pm.

On Monday evening at 5pm and 6pm tours of the Waddell Mariculture Center with Dr. Al Stokes will take place on the bluff of the Colleton River highlighting our natural resources and the necessary conservation practices to ensure their continuance.

Wednesday again offers Author Night 5:30 – 8:30pm at the Rotary Community Center in Oscar Frazier Park, "Celebrate the Rich History & Culture of the Lowcountry" through the art of internationally acclaimed Gullah Artist & Storyteller Sonja Griffin Evans.

Other favorite returning events include daily May River paddle board and boat tours, Bluffton Jack's Haunted History Tours, Bluffton Self Help's Sips and Seafood Party at Waddell Mariculture Center,



the Saturday morning Old Town Oyster 10K and 5K run, children's fishing tournament and expanded children's art activities in the park.

New to this year's events include the "Bluffton State of Mind Supper Soirée" which takes place from 6-9pm on Saturday, Oct. 13, "Children's Cooking Class", from 1-3pm at Venue 1223 on Sunday, Oct. 14, "Tap and Table" dinner, from 6-8pm at Venue 1223 on Tuesday, Oct. 16, and the daily scheduled "Gullah Village" at the Boundary Street Cultural Center.

The highlight of the week again is the outdoor "Street Fest", Saturday, Oct 20 - Sunday, Oct 21, which features the juried "Artist Showcase and Market" on Calhoun Street with over 100 artists from 10 different states.
