Ella Walton Richardson Fine Art in Charleston, SC, Offers Works by Evgeny and Lydia Baranov

The Ella Walton Richardson Fine Art
in Charleston, SC, will present *Evgeny &
Lydia Baranov: European Vacation
Exhibition*, on view from Apr. 6 - 30,
2018. A reception will be held on Apr. 6,
from 5-8pm.

They say a painting is a work of love;
nowhere is this more true than the works
of Evgeny and Lydia Baranov. A Russian-
born duo, the Baranovs married and began
collaborating in their artwork over 25
years ago. Together they divide a canvas
as easily as you or I would slice a cake,
yet their styles blend so perfectly that the
division is not distinct. As plein air paint-
ers, they paint strictly outside, focusing
on one city at a time. "European Vac-
ation" highlights their time spent in several
cities throughout Western Europe. From
sailboats to sumptuous still-lives, the Bara-
novs take us on a vacation to remember.

In the past six years, the Baranovs have
become enamored with the subject of
sailboats. From 2012-2018, they focused
on Honfleur, France and from there
traveled to Bruges, Belgium. Their most
recent exploration lead them to Hoorn, a
historic port filled with enchanting Dutch
"flatboats." The restored old vessels lining
the Hoorn harbor proved to be exciting

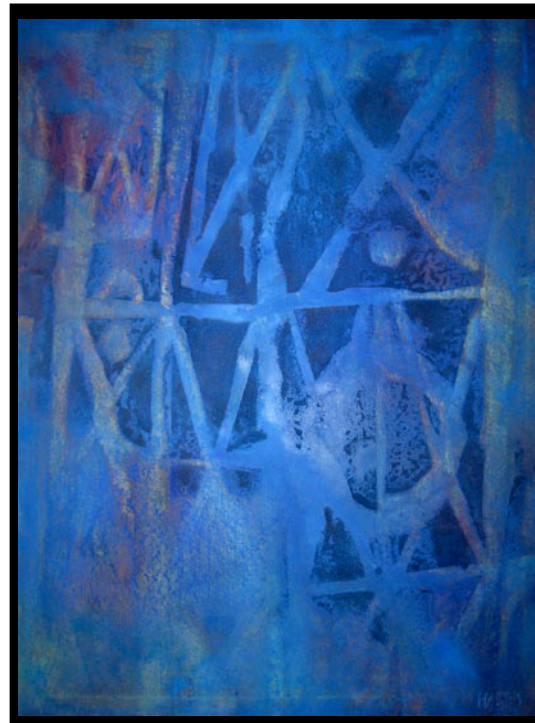

and inspirational subjects, though they
presented some unique challenges. "It was
quite difficult," Lydia explained, "to start
a painting and the next day return only to
find that "our" boat was gone and two oth-
ers were in its place." Yet, the Baranovs
have learned to thrive on these inconsis-
tencies. Using differences in light and sub-
ject, they work together to create the most
exquisite array of scenes imaginable.

Born in Moscow, the Baranovs are in-
ternationally recognized for their expertise
in plein-air paintings. Before becoming
fine artists, both received their Masters of
Science in Architecture from the Moscow
Architectural Institute. The precision and
attention to detail required of this degree
is evident in their paintings, as is their
high level artistic ability. Notable col-
lectors of their work include the Royal
Family of the United Kingdom, the Hearst
Family, the Clint Eastwood Family, and

The works in this exhibition are not
identifiable as particular places; they are
intended to recall our shared experiences
of the environment we inhabit, escape to,
and through which we renew ourselves.
Using oil paint, paint sticks, cold wax
medium, unorthodox application tools,
and other media, layers are built up and
excavated to develop the complex yet sim-
ple atmospheres that embody these works.
The journey into the landscape is calm-
ing, invigorating, and part of our common
experience.

Ulrich has studied with internationally
known painters and has been fortunate
to have completed residencies in Wash-
ington state and Scotland. She grew up
in the wide-open vistas of central Texas
and believes the horizon has always been

integral in her work. Ulrich states, "I paint
to unearth the unseen from the familiar. I
look to the edge and strive to uncover the
texture of the horizon. I want you to slow
down and experience the complicated
simplicity of the world through my eyes.
I want to help you to stop. See. Zoom in.
