Ella Walton Richardson Fine Art in Charleston, SC, will present *Grandeur*, featuring works by Lindsay Goodwin, on view from June 7 through July 15, 2013. A reception will be held on June 7, from 5-8pm.

At the young age of 30, Goodwin has soared to the top as one of the country's most collected oil painters. A California native and a graduate of the renowned Academy of Art University in San Francisco, Goodwin was chosen as one of the top fifteen emerging artists among her entire graduating class, and it has been history ever since. She already has numerous awards under her belt, and has garnered attention from every national art publication, including *American Art Collector*, *Plein Air*, the *San Francisco Chronicle*, and *Southwest Art*.

One of her most sought after recognitions is her recent inclusion in *Southwest Art's* annual "Top 21 Artists under 31" spread in their Sept. 2005 issue. In Dec. 2008 Goodwin was showcased in *American Art Collector's* largest feature article to date, with an 8-page spread of her feature show that year. Most recently, Goodwin received an Honorable Mention from Oil Painters of America for her painting,

Glenn Harrington, accomplished fine artist and illustrator, is noted for his exquisite portraits and for his paintings of the sport of golf. In 1981, Harrington graduated from Pratt Institute in New York City and quickly began his career in illustration and painting. The artistic journey for Harrington began as a young boy under his father's tutelage with his formal training culminating in a degree from the Pratt Institute in New York.

First embarking on a career as an illustrator, Harrington has had more than

500 book covers published including such classics as Wuthering Heights, Pride and Prejudice and Room with a View. The transition to fine artist was a natural progression for such a gifted painter. He explores the easy solitude one feels when comfortable in their surroundings through capturing unguarded moments, when simple truths can be seen in a wistful smile, in the tilt of a head or in a pair of daydreaming eyes.
